Soon after, both writer and heroine became icons and international bestsellers. Ms. Grafton was a writer who consistently broke the bonds of genre while never writing the same book twice. Books by Sue Grafton: The Kinsey Millhone Alphabet Series G is for Gumshoe. Kinsey is run off the road by a red pickup truck, wrecking her '68 Volkswagen and landing herself in the hospital.
